

Are you registered? Below are race day FAQs.

ON YOUR MARK!

IMPORTANT RACE DAY INFO

Welcome to the oldest footrace in the state of Washington. We want you to have a great race day! Please take a moment to read this information.

When can I pick up my timing chip?

- Race day only: Saturday, July 8, 7:00 - 8:30 AM at Marine Park (near Bellingham Cruise Terminal, located in the Fairhaven district, Bellingham, WA).
- **Please give yourself plenty of time to pick up your chip so that you have a relaxing race morning!**

Where can I park?

- Racers and spectators can park near start line at **designated** lots by the Bellingham Cruise Terminal.
- Race starts at Fairhaven's Marine Park, follows a seven-mile trail, and finishes at Larrabee State Park.
- **IMPORTANT! No parking at the finish or in Fairhaven's shopping district. Fairhaven spaces are for shoppers. Please follow this race-day rule — merchants have generously donated prizes.**

How do the free shuttle buses work?

- Just after the race starts, spectators can ride free shuttles from the start at Marine Park to the finish at Larrabee State Park.
- At end of event, racers and spectators can ride free shuttle buses back to Marine Park.

Where will restrooms and water stations be?

- Restrooms will be at start and finish. Port-a-johns will be at North Chuckanut Drive trailhead (about 2.5 miles) and Cleator Road (about 5 miles).
- Water stations, staffed and stocked with water and sport drink, will be on course, about 2.5 miles apart.
